YEAR IN REVIEW

Overview

The American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) at the University of Houston is a non-profit organization focused on providing a community and professional development opportunities for all future engineers. Through various enrichment opportunities we, as an organization, are able to assist in the development of our members' professional skill sets. AIChE Professional Development

Throughout this past year, we were able to provide our members with various professional development opportunities. From resume critiques, to mock interviews, to setting up Q&A sessions with industry professionals, we have provided them with opportunities to refine their professional skill set. Throughout the 2019 – 2020 academic school year, our organization hosted 7 information sessions along with 2 professional development events. Additionally, we had the opportunity to facilitate internship and full time recruiting for one company in the Houston area. Through our focus on professional development, we were able prepare our members to be equipped in their job search as well as be successful in the professional world.

YEAR IN REVIEW

Charter School Program at UH

The Charter School Program is an outreach initiative founded three years ago. It provides 3rd through 5th grade girls with opportunities to learn about different STEM concepts with topics ranging from understanding different molecular structures to the applications of computer programming. In the spring semester, AIChE collaborated extensively with Honors Engineering Program in order to expand the Charter School Program, now with a program membership of around 30 engineering students. In the Fall semester, AIChE took part in a K12 competition at the national conference held in Orlando, Florida. The purpose of the competition was to explore wonders of STEM and to increase interest in science and engineering in K12 students and to prepare future engineering students to creatively solve technical challenges in an ethical, sustainable, and socially conscious way. We presented our ideas on "Alternative Fuels" and our energy experiment was demonstrated to 100+ K12 students, their parents and educators, and members of the AIChE community.

**At the 2019 AIChE regional conference, the Charter School Program was recognized for Engaging Young Women in STEM.

Chem-E Car

The Chem-E Car competition provides our members with an opportunity to apply their technical knowledge and also a chance to gain lab experience. Before they begin developing a car for the competition, they have to go through different trainings and get various safety certifications in order to participate. The development and testing of their car, in preparation for the competition, allows them to apply and refine their problem-solving skills in a more technical setting. The Chem-E car team brought home 4th place at the 2019 Regional Chem-E Car Competition at Texas Tech University. The team now consists of 20 members who are working on developing a car for the 2021 Regional Competition.

Our Goals for the 2020–2021 Year

In general, AIChE has made strides forward in an effort to raise the level of engagement for the organization as well as provide our members with valuable professional experiences and opportunities. The officer board for the 2020–2021 year have broader goal in hopes of making an impact not only within our organization but also within our community. Listed below are the goals we hope to achieve in the upcoming school year.

- Increase membership retention and engagement
- Expand the Charter School Program to include more organizations and more activities
- Increase participation in general volunteering activities
- Strengthen and expand our connections with alumni and industry professionals from a wider range of industries

- Expand on professional development opportunities currently available for our members
- Sustain virtual meetings and professional development opportunities if required
- Develop relationships with other AIChE chapters
